


Phase 1 Proposed Regulations



Phase 1 Management Strategies:

1. Establish consistent, regular enforcement

Purpose:

- Balance parking demands equitably
- Increase turnover of on-street spaces
- Reduce spillover parking from other areas
- Create customer service focused parking system

2. Provide a Free Employee Parking Permit Program


Purpose:

- Provide an equitable parking solution for employees of Aggieville
- Decrease traffic congestion from “Employee shuffle”
- Increase customer access to area businesses
- Reduce spillover impacts to surrounding areas

Phase 2 Management Strategies:

Option 1: Implementation of Paid Parking

Strategy: Ongoing Enforcement of New Regulations

Purpose:

- Continue to promote compliance with parking regulations

Strategy: Implementation of Paid Parking

Purpose:

- Support funding of a managed parking system
- Encourage turnover of on-street parking spaces
- Redistribute parking demands to underutilized facilities and areas

Strategy: Updated Employee Parking Permit Program

Purpose:

- Possible implementation of a paid permits supports funding administration of the program and enforcement of the parking system

Option 2: Continue “Free” Parking

Potential funding sources:

- Taxpayers through the City’s General Fund
- Business Improvement District through additional property taxes
