



Q1 Which of these City of Manhattan buildings or parking structures do you visit regularly? (Choose all that apply.)























Q14 Have you encountered difficulties crossing a street near a City of Manhattan building or park due to lack of pedestrian push buttons and pedestrian signals?











Q19 Do you have difficulties accessing public schools in Manhattan due to inaccessibility of sidewalks or curb ramps near the school?















Q26 On a scale of 1 to 5, how would you rate the accessibility of the City of Manhattan's public amenities overall?



Q27 On a scale of 1 to 5, how would you rate the accessibility of the City of Manhattan’s programs, services and activities overall?



Q28 Is the City of Manhattan accommodating of persons with disabilities?




