

Sunset Cemetery Master Plan

History

- 1860: 35 acres established; 10 acres added in 1909
- 1869: 15 acres sold to fund stone fence
- 1885: 15 acres sold back to City
- 1908: name changed to Sunset Hill
- 1910: Cemetery Sexton house constructed
- 1917: Memorial arch constructed
- 1931: Paslay Tower constructed
- 1932-34: current stone fence constructed through WPA
- 1962: Paslay Tower repaired
- 1982: fire ended chiming of Paslay Tower
- 1990s: asphalt road overlayed
- 2001: Paslay Tower renovated

Concept Objectives

- Prioritize construction of a new shop facility
- Determine location of the new shop facility
- Determine if Cemetery Sexton's house can be sold
- Install Columbariums south of the tower
- Reconstruct cemetery roads
- Install new irrigation system
- Install ADA accessible sidewalk at the entry
- Address settling of the memorial arch
