ORDINANCE NO. 7775

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A STORMWATER TREATMENT ALTERNATIVE FUND; AND, ESTABLISHING THE AUTHORIZED EXPENDITURES FROM SAID FUND.

WHEREAS, the governing body is implementing an Alternative Offsite Stormwater Treatment Program (Program); and,

WHEREAS, the Program will be enabled by governing body action and enacted by various instruments, including Program Standards developed by City staff and approved and adopted pursuant to an administrative process, and such instruments will be collectively referred to hereafter as the “Program Documents”; and,

WHEREAS, developers participating in the Program will remit fees to the City of Manhattan, as described in the Program Documents; and,

WHEREAS, Program income will be exclusively used to pay for Program expenses, including fees to be paid to participating producers, as described in the Program Documents; and,

WHEREAS, the governing body desires to establish a Stormwater Treatment Alternative Fund to receive such fees, and to authorize certain expenditures from said Fund.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Manhattan:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created, for the City of Manhattan (City), a budgeted, interest-bearing, and restricted special fund, to be known as the Stormwater Treatment Alternative Fund (Fund).

SECTION 2. Moneys received by the City through its Alternative Offsite Stormwater Treatment Program (Program) will be deposited into the Fund.

SECTION 3. Moneys in the Fund may only be used for purposes of the Program. No moneys shall be transferred from other funds, unless budgeted for, nor shall any moneys in the Fund be transferred to other funds.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect after its publication once in the official City newspaper.

ORDINANCE NO. 7775 SUMMARY

On October 7, 2025, the City of Manhattan, Kansas adopted the following ordinance:
